CONDITIONS OF CAMPING

- Maximum stay time 7 days
- Caravans, Motor Homes, Roof top campers, and tents are acceptable
- A donation for use of the area would be appreciated: we suggest \$10 per night
 - Donations may be made over the counter in the bar (EFTPOS Available) or in the donation box in the Jinker Display shed.
- Camping is at your own risk. The club takes no responsibility for any damage to your vehicles and effects whilst camped on this land.
- Please camp in the areas defined by lines
- Please do not camp in the car park area or the emergency vehicle access track to the west of the palms and near the firewater tank.
- Please maintain your camp in clean condition and dispose of waste in the red lid bins provided.
- Please minimise the use of generators, do not operate before 8am or after 8pm.
- Deposit bottles cans and cartons can be disposed of in bins provided. Funds from these assist the club in meeting its costs.
- In accord with Adelaide Plains Council By Laws:
 - O Dogs must be on leash at all times
 - No open fires are permitted
- RV Dump Points are available at the campground or at the rear of the Lions park in Dublin
- A Laundromat is available in Dublin
